

PAPER KITE CRAFT

You'll need:



Instructions:

1. Decorate both sides of a piece of paper.
2. Fold the paper in half lengthwise to form a crease down the center. Unfold it.
3. Fold the top corners of the paper down to the center crease to form a triangle.
4. Fold the bottom of the paper up to meet the top of the triangle to form a smaller triangle.
5. Cut two notches, about 1 inch (2.5 cm) long, along the folded edge of the paper, about 1 inch (2.5 cm) from the center crease.
6. Insert one straw into each notch, with straws parallel to the center crease, and tape them in place.
7. Trim the excess length of the straws to about 1 inch (2.5 cm) longer than the width of the paper.
8. Fold the paper over the straws, tape the paper to the straws along both edges, leaving a small gap between the straws at the top.
9. Tie a string to the center crease of the kite, and tie the other end to a spool or reel.
10. Tie a longer string to each end of the crosspiece (straws) as kite tails.
11. Take your kite to an open area with plenty of space and wind, hold it up by the string, and let it fly!
